ADVANCING THE ART OF CATARACT CARE

Thanks to recent advancements in diagnostics, lens implant technology and surgical techniques, cataract surgery has become one of the safest and most effective surgical procedures performed today. Each year more than one million seniors have their cataracts successfully removed.

At Coastal Eye Care, we specialize in the most advanced methods of cataract surgery including both sutureless and bladeless Laser Assisted Cataract Surgery and specialty refractive intraocular lens (IOL) technologies, including multifocal IOLs, astigmatic correcting TORIC IOLs along with laser corneal relaxing incisions with the aim of decreasing dependence on glasses postoperatively. Our goal is to allow patients to enjoy a

more rapid visual recovery and return to the things they enjoy most in life.

We will help you make a more informed decision on which cataract surgery and intraocular lens implant options are best suited to your desired outcome. Your lifestyle, hobbies and normal daily activities actually play an important role in helping us customize a cataract surgery plan that is tailor made to fit your needs.

LENS IMPLANT OPTIONS:

At Coastal Eye Care, exciting breakthroughs in lens implant technology are now allowing our cataract patients to enjoy a higher quality of vision. In the past, patients undergoing cataract surgery were limited to a monofocal (single focus) intraocular lens (IOL). Monofocal IOLs implanted in both eyes generally provide excellent distance vision, but patients may still need spectacle correction for near and intermediate vision.

Recent approvals by the Food & Drug Administration (FDA) allow our surgeons to offer an array of premium IOLs. Fortunately, Medicare now allows our patients to upgrade their vision using these new and improved IOLs. These include lenses that can give you a much broader range of vision after cataract surgery with little or no dependence on corrective eyewear. Our choice of lenses allows us to customize your vision from improving night vision and driving capabilities as well as correcting astigmatism at the time of your cataract surgery.

Although approved by Medicare, these lenses are not fully covered by Medicare or the insurance industry. Our counselors will help explain what portions of your cataract procedures are covered by Medicare and/ or insurance and what out-of-pocket expenses you may incur.

WHAT IS A CATARACT?

Cataracts are simply a natural part of the aging process that is taking place inside your eye. It's a gradual clouding of the normally clear natural lens of the eye. Although barely noticeable in its early stages, over time, this clouding process makes your vision less sharp, reducing your contrast and making activities like night driving and reading more difficult.
